Admission policy for Long/short trainees

- The School of Information Technology(SIT) will offer short term training programme (B.Tech/MCA/B.Pharm/MBBS/M.Sc or equivalent degree) from May to July and December to January every year.
- The SIT will also offer long term training programme(4-6 months) for B.Tech/B.pharm/MBBS/M.Sc or equivalent degree final year students who have to do their project and submit project report to the affiliated institute or university. The training will be provided in various fields like Computational Biology, System Biology, Molecular Modeling, Drug Design, Robotics etc.
- Applications will be processed in April and November every year. After getting
 the applications with directly from the students and received by individual faculty,
 a committee will screen and allocate the students to the interested faculty
 members.
- No. of Long Term Trainees: 8 (4-6 months) B.Tech/B.Pharm/MBBS/MSc or equivalent degree students for projects
- No of Short Term Trainees: 10 (2-3 months) B.Tech/B.Pharm/MBBS/MSc or equivalent degree students(extendable to Longterm trainee)
- Total number of trainees(maximum) at any given time (long term and short term trainees): 18
- All the trainees will be located in Hall-4
- Trainees will not get payment of scholarship and accommodation.

All the trainees must indicate research area, the training period and date of joining in their application.

All the prospective applicants must provide one/two recommendation letters from their respective institute/university. Only one or two will be admitted from one institute/university. The preference will be given to the students coming from less privileged institutes/universities.

- Trainee must submit a written and e-copy of the project accomplished during the
 project duly signed by supervisor. The project report may also have a certificate to
 protect the Intellectual property/Copyright with the supervisor which will be
 property of the School. A certificate will be issued in this regard only upon
 successful completion of the project.
- All the foreign students may be admitted as casual students and their applications may be processed by Foreign Students Cell at JNU.
